What is Sensei Monitor?

Sensei Monitor is a new feature that is released as part of the Sensei 1.5 update. It is made up by two parts:

- A standalone app for monitoring Mac performance metrics, that lives in the status bar and can launch/run independently of the main Sensei app.
- A dedicated section in Sensei with an editor where the user can completely customize what tracking they want and the status item and panel design.

What's your edge vs competitors?

Sensei Monitor features a brand new approach, with a modular widget system for both status item and panel. Users can create and customise widgets and panels, and edit their layout easily with the drag & drop editor. Together with a new design that looks just right on modern macOS, it's the ultimate menu bar performance monitor for the Mac. Built from the ground up with a modern approach using SwiftUI, it features amazing performance and uses less background resources than similar apps.

What is Cindori?

Cindori is a company dedicated to enhancing the Mac experience. We've developed apps like Trim Enabler, Disk Sensei, Command Center, and VR Desktop, which are used by millions of Mac users worldwide.

Who is behind Cindori?

[Oskar Groth](#) is the founder and sole developer behind Cindori. Ever since he got his first Mac, Oskar has been pushing the boundaries of the platform. He started out writing AppleScript apps to flash PC graphics cards for use in the Mac Pro, before learning Objective-C and creating Trim Enabler. He then later received his M.S. in Computer Science from Lund University while honing his skills as a Mac developer. Today he's living in Stockholm, writing apps in Swift and SwiftUI, and more committed than ever to enhancing the Mac experience.

What is Sensei?

Sensei is a brand new app for monitoring, optimizing, and maintaining your Mac computer. It's an app with a wide range of features revolving around hardware health/statistics, disk cleaning, app uninstallation, and much more.

What are the main features?

Sensei has a very wide range of features spanning both Hardware and Software. Some of the more notable ones include:

Performance Dashboard: A modular overview of CPU/GPU/RAM/Storage statistics. Coming as a menu bar item later in Q1.

Disk Cleaner: A blazing-fast file scanner that will find and list files that are taking up large amounts of disk space and let you delete them.

App Uninstaller: A super-easy-to-use app uninstaller that will scan for apps located anywhere on your computer and let you uninstall them safely, including all their hidden helper tools, logs, and other files littering your system.

What's your edge?

Sensei offers a much wider range of features than any of its competitors. It offers a monitoring suite that rivals iStat Menus (menu item feature coming in Q1), a Disk Cleaner and App Uninstaller that rivals CleanMyMac X, a thermal dashboard and fan control (coming Q1) that rivals TG Pro, and disk S.M.A.R.T health analysis that rivals DriveDx. All this while also offering additional features such as Battery health report, Disk Benchmark, SSD Trim Enabler, and much more. The design of Sensei is also one of its main features. We've handcrafted every pixel and component in the UI, and designed our own hi-fidelity icons and artwork depicting various hardware. We're also launching Sensei at a very competitive price.

What's your traction?

Sensei has been in early access since December, with no advertising, and we've already gained 3000 MAU and had very positive feedback. The pre-release sales have already overtaken our other products, and Sensei is now our #1 product, one day out from public launch.

Pricing options?

Sensei can be bought on a subscription basis or as a traditional, lifetime license.

Sensei works on any Mac running **macOS 10.15 Catalina**. We've deliberately targeted the latest macOS from the beginning in order to continue building upon and supporting Sensei for many years to come.

Sensei is launching in English and Swedish, but will expand to include French, German and Spanish during Q1, and later Chinese, Russian and Japanese.
